Our aim is to ensure this platform is an inclusive and constructive space where users can share their views and ideas about key areas of the Restoration and Renewal Programme. We welcome debate and discussion between users. Please ensure your comments are constructive and if you disagree with a comment made by another user, do so respectfully.

When taking part in this conversation, please ensure;

- You are respectful of others' views and ideas,
- That your contributions are relevant to the questions and conversation,
- You report any content that breaks these community guidelines to help us keep this site a safe space for everyone.

Therefore, as a participant in this online conversation you agree that you will not:

- Deliberately insult, intimidate, threaten, attack or harass others, including on the basis of race, ethnic background, nationality, sex, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, religion, nationality, medical condition, philosophical affiliation, age, disability, illness, or any other characteristic
- Incite or encourage others to insult, intimidate, threaten, attack or harass others, including on the basis of race, ethnic background, nationality, sex, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, religion, nationality, medical condition, philosophical affiliation, age, disability, illness, or any other characteristic
- Post content that could cause personal distress to other users, and/or which relates to others' personal loss or grief
- Directly or indirectly promote terrorism, violence or extremist views
- Use this platform to advertise products or services, or for campaigning
- Impersonate others, nor via the platform undertake actions or communications which deceive others
- Register or use more than one account at the same time
- Use an inappropriate profile name. We encourage you to use the name you prefer to be known by in your daily life. However, if you have privacy or safety concerns, you are welcome to use a different name. Profile names must not impersonate another person (living or dead), other users, or brands, and must be in line with the rest of these community guidelines



- Publish or post confidential data and private information about yourself or others. This includes credit card numbers, address details, telephone numbers or other data that constitute the personal private information of a person
- Share your personal contact details, or ask another user for theirs. If you choose to provide links to social networks such as Twitter or Facebook, please make sure you are happy with your privacy settings before you do so.
- ‘Spam’ other users or the platform by posting the same comment multiple times, or by posting comments that are unrelated to the engagement activity. Identical (or near-identical) comments posted repeatedly will be considered spam
- Post significantly diverging or completely off-topic comments
- Post content of a party political nature
- Post malicious content or images, or links to such content, for the purpose of damaging or disrupting someone else's browsers or computers, or of violating someone's privacy.
- Infringe any applicable laws. This includes infringements against privacy legislation and intellectual property rights
- Refer to active legal proceedings, post material protected by an injunction or court order, that accuses and identifiable person or organisation of wrongdoing (such as committing a crime or serious misconduct) or post materials that could be confidential or commercially sensitive
- Use the platform in any way to promote illegal activities

How does moderation work?

To ensure this platform is an inclusive and safe space where users can share their views on key areas of the Restoration and Renewal Programme, our team of moderations will remove any contributions perceived as breaching the Community Guidelines set out above. When a comment is removed the author will be notified by email.

Users can report unacceptable content by clicking on the three dots on the top right corner of the post to report it. Please indicate the reason you are reporting the content - this will send a notification for the post to be reviewed by our team of moderators.

Those who persistently violate the Community Guidelines and Terms and conditions may have their user profile suspended or permanently deleted.

All actions and decisions taken by our team of moderators are final.

We are using automated tools provided by the platform supplier which will notify you before you post if your comment contains language deemed unacceptable. Please review your text to check for this or any other errors, and consider how to rephrase your comment.
